

KS1 Little Big Sing 24/25

Project Outline

Little Big Sing is our KS1 singing offer for 4-7yr olds. It brings together multiple locality schools at a host school for a half-day singing workshop, led by one of our specialist singing leaders. We provide resources for two songs for participants to learn prior to the event, which schools rehearse and perform together in a massed choir on the day. Participating schools will also be asked to perform a song of their choice with backing track or live piano/guitar accompaniment, which gives students the experience of performing to a large audience.

CPD

At the heart of a Little Big Sing event is our **FREE** CPD for primary school teachers of all levels of musical experience and confidence, led by Schools Singing Leader, Rachel Maby. Teachers will explore singing warm-ups, musical games and model session plans in preparation for the Little Big Sing event.

The Music

This year's theme is Harvest and we have chosen the following songs for the mass choir items, for teachers to prepare with their students prior to the event:

Schools will be provided all learning resources for each song, which includes sheet music, learning tracks, backing tracks, lyrics sheets and performance tracks. We request that the participating students sing the mass songs off-copy for the performance.

School Song Choice: schools are requested to perform one song by themselves at the concert, which compliments the theme of harvest. Teachers can choose a song of their choice with either live accompaniment or backing track.
